It is my pleasure to write this recommendation letter for Bara Cihlova who is applying for a fellowship with your foundation. Bara applied to join my group at Institute of Organic Chemistry and Biochemistry two years ago which we allow for highly motivated high school students. That was clearly Bara's case. She was deeply interested in natural sciences and medicine and her theoretical knowledge was far above average for her academic age.

Bara joined our ongoing efforts to deeply understand the Tick-borne encephalitis virus (TBEV) to develop enzyme inhibitors that could be used to as antivirals. Bara is now a competent scientist working independently, during the last two years she has learned and mastered several difficult methods of molecular biology such as polymerase chain reaction (PCR), DNA isolation from bacteria, preparation of expression plasmids, and expression and purification of recombinant proteins.
